Red, White & Blue Golf Tournament July 4, 2011



Time: Tee Times, Any time all day, July 4th. Make your own time.

Format: Individual Stroke Play, 100% of handicap. Will pay gross and net winners. There will also be a ladies division separate from the Men's.

Tees: Holes 1-6 Red tees, Holes 7-12 White tees, Holes 13-18 Blue tees.

Ladies will play from the 200 yard marker on holes 1-6, Red tees on holes 7-12, and from the white tees on holes 13-18.

Cost: \$10/person: 100% of entry fee is going toward prizes. Will pay 30% of field.

Optional Skins game - \$10 per person

Ties: All ties will be broken by a scorecard playoff starting with the last 9 holes and if there is still a tie the last 6 holes and then the last 3 holes.

Rain policy: RRGC will make every attempt possible to complete the tournament on this date. There is no alternate date.

Payout: based on 12 people

TIME: First round is to be completed from June 6-June 26. The remaining matches will be given a specific date as to when the match is to be completed so that the next round of matches can then begin. If the match is not completed by the set date both teams will be disqualified from the event.

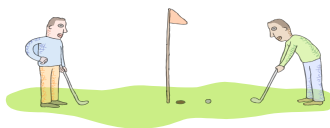
FORMAT: Team match play with 100% of handicap used to determine strokes between players. Your June 1 handicap index will be used for the duration of the tournament. The lowest handicap contestant in each match will play at scratch, others receiving the difference between their handicaps and his.

PRICE: \$20 per person which includes prizes.

FLIGHTS: Since this is a net event, only one flight will be used. A blind drawing will be held to set the field. Byes will be used in the event of odd number of players.

PRIZES: The number and amount of prizes will be determined by the number of participants. 100% of entry fee will be used for prizes.

Time: 10:30 AM tee times Tuesday

Format: Gross, Stroke Play.



Boys: The Jr Club Champion will be the low gross score playing 18 holes from the blue tees. The Super Jr Club Champion will be the low gross score playing 9 holes from the red tees. The Super Jr Club Champion must be 10 or under. No carts are allowed. Walking is required.

Girls: The Girls Jr Club Champion will be the low gross score playing 9 holes from the red tees. There will be no age groups in the girls division.

Cost: \$10/person: Includes prizes and hot dog lunch before your round. 66% of entry fee is going toward prizes. Will pay 30% of field

Ties: A tie for the Championship will be a sudden death playoff starting on hole number 1. All other ties will be broken by a scorecard playoff starting with the lowest handicapped hole.

Rain policy: RRJC will make every attempt possible to complete the tournament on these dates.

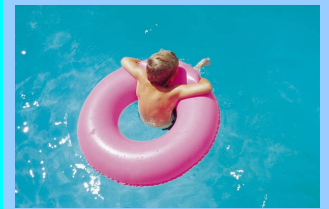

Turf Talk

Rodney Moss, Superintendent


It is June and It is HOT! If you're out playing golf make sure you drink plenty of water and keep putting on the sunscreen! It looks like another hot summer is going to be in store for us!

We are in full grass cutting mode out on the golf course. We are cutting twice a week when we can. The bermuda grass started growing like crazy once the temperatures jumped up into the 90's. With the increased heat we have starting hand watering greens as well. There may be times when you have to wait to hit your shot. We will be on and off the green as quick as we can.

We are planning on spiking the greens with solid tines on June 7th. No cores will be pulled and the holes should heal over in two or three days. The greens will be topdressed as well. Putting sand down really helps firm up the greens as well as reduce thatch buildup. Using the solid tines really helps vent the greens allowing oxygen and water to better penetrate the surface of the greens. The greens will be rolled also. I want to start rolling more often with the heat starting to build.
