Men's Club Championship October 15-16

Time: Tee times begin at 7:30 each day. Contact the pro shop to find out your tee time.

Format: Gross, Stroke Play within each flight. Tournament will be preflighted. Members with 5 handicap index or below will be in the Championship flight. Anyone else wishing to play in the Championship flight may do so. **Please inform us.** All other flights will be preflighted according to handicap indexes, with an optimum number of participants in each flight being 6 golfers.

Tees: Championship: **Gold**; Remaining flights: **Blue** (no senior tees)

Cost: \$30/person: 100% of your entry is going to Prizes for this event. You may walk or purchase a cart at applicable rates.

Optional Skins game - \$10 per person per day (not flighted)

Ties: All flights for first place will be a sudden-death playoff. All other ties will be the gross score of holes 10-18 from Sunday. If there is still a tie, the winner will be determined by the score of holes 13-18, then 16-18 and finally the 18th hole.

Rain policy: RRGc will make every attempt possible to complete the tournament on these dates. If one day is rained out, scores from the other day will determine winners.

Payout: based on 6 participants/flight

70%, 30%, per flight ~ 1st place-\$126/person, 2nd place-\$54/person

NEW 2011 Tournament of Champions



November 19-20 2011

Any member who has won first place in a flight in a member tournament in 2011 will be invited to participate in this event. Invitations will be sent out later this month.

Time: Saturday-Tee times start at 8:30. 9 am shotgun on Sunday.

Format: Points Quota System, adjusting by half your differential for Sunday's round. 36 minus your handicap is your quota. Points will be given using the following structure: Bogey-1, Par-2, Birdie-4, Eagle, Double Eagle or Hole in One-6. The person with the most over their quota is the winner. We will adjust your Quota for Sunday's round by half of Saturday's score. For example: Saturday quota is 20, you pull 24 points. Your score for the tournament is +4. Your quota for Sunday will be 22. If you were to pull 15 points on Saturday, your score for the tournament is -5. Your quota for Sunday will be 17.5. We will use decimals. We will have a Men's Flight and a Ladies Flight.

Tees: You decide. We will adjust your handicap accordingly. Please inform us which tee you will play when you accept your invitation.

Cost: \$10 to cover F&B on Sunday after the round. RRGc will provide \$300 worth of gift certificates for place winners. Optional skin game both days. \$10 per person. Cart fees will be regular rate. You may walk if you wish.

Ties: First place in all flights will be a chip off from the driving range tee to the chipping green. All other ties will be the Quota system of holes 10-18 from Sunday. If there is still a tie, the winner will be determined by the score of holes 13-18, then 16-18 and finally the 18th hole.

Rain policy: RRGc will make every attempt possible to complete the tournament on these dates. If one day is rained out, scores from the other day will determine winners.
