



Governor Roy Cooper has announced a modest step forward for North Carolina that moves our state into Phase 2.5 effective September 4. In response to Governor Cooper's mandate, River Ridge Golf Club is easing cart restrictions to get back to more normal golf operations.

**Effective Tuesday September 8, we will require only 2 golf carts per foursome or threesome, and 1 golf cart per twosome.**

Any golfer who insists on having their own golf cart will be required to pay a \$25 surcharge.

River Ridge has endured an economic setback over the last 5 months. Single golf cart riders forced us to reduce our tee time inventory by 1/3. Pairing golfers in carts will allow us to book more rounds and maximize dollars per cart. Our golf carts have endured heavy usage and abnormal wear allowing for single golf cart riders over the last 5 months. The golf course has seen more wear and tear, especially cart path edges, due to more carts on the course. The State of NC does not have a hard rule regarding golf cart riders. However, we feel like if the Governor is comfortable with 8 people sitting together having dinner inside a restaurant, it is okay to have 2 people riding in a golf cart in the open air together.

We appreciate your understanding of this necessary option for our golf club to slowly return to more normal operations. We look forward to fully opening our tee sheet so we can provide more golfers an escape to the golf course and experience the wonderful outdoor sport of golf.
